

## To enter Kenya

**Covid-19 Test Required:** Passengers, including transit passengers, must have a printed medical certificate with a negative PCR test result taken within 96 hours prior to arrival, and a code proving they have uploaded it on [PanBIOS](#) for verification prior to departure. The medical certificate must be in English.

- **Covid-19 Form Required:** Passengers must hold a QR code showing they have completed a Travelers Health Surveillance Form online prior to departure. This is completed by downloading the 'Jitenge MoH Kenya' app on iOS or Android, or on the [Ministry of Health website](#).
- **Covid-19 Form During Flight:** Passengers are required to fill in a Passenger Locator Form during their flight to Kenya.
- **Covid-19 Test Required on Departure:** Passengers departing South Africa must hold a negative PCR test certificate or a valid Covid-19 negative test certificate from an accredited laboratory certified by the South African Health Products Regulatory Authority (SAHPRA) and South African National Accreditation System (SANAS).

## To enter South Africa

**Covid-19 Test Required:** Passengers must hold a negative PCR test certificate recognised by the World Health Organisation obtained within 72 hours prior to departure from the date of examination.
